It does not keep attached to the article metadata, it is just displayed on the article website.

If you modify the text, it will automatically show in both current and older articles.






Differences between the Copyright Notice and the Licence Terms



If your copyright policy is not very long, you may copy the same text in both fields to keep it simple.





Differences between the Copyright Notice and the Licence Terms



It is advisable to mention that the full copyright statement can be found in the website

Journals with very detailed copyright description that looks too long to be included in the article website, or do not want to repeat some information of the article metadata such the licences.

Also journals that want to show other important elements from other policies in the article website, e.g. self-repository policy.





Where should the copyright policy be? – Article PDF

Usually, in the first page, also in the last page, or in all the pages.

It is preferable that all the copyright key elements (copyright holder, license, year of publication) are close to each other, al least once in the article.

Style freedom, they can be logos, links, shorter or larger information.

In advanced copyediting, it could also be included in the PDF metadata.



Does the current copyright policy of the journal applies to all the published issues?

Maybe yes, if the journal was born with this copyright policy.

Or maybe not, if the journal does not have a clear copyright policy since the first issue, or if the journal have changed it through time.

It is not correct nor legal to apply a new copyright policy to older issues retrospectively.





Why is important to know the previous copyright policy?

- To reflect the truth and avoid giving misleading information.
- Because authors, librarians and all the people have to know what can they do with they older articles, for example to deposit them in their institutional repositories.
- Because journals have to know which issues can be indexed in commercial databases with the full text copied.
- Because some repositories such as DOAJ requires a very clear copyright policy.
- In older journals that are already in OJS, to correct copyright metadata errors.
- In new journals that are born/are about to be migrated to OJS, to avoid correcting errors in the future.






What if a journal does not have a stated copyright policy?

Then the national copyright law of the journal country will apply, and it is highly probably that is based on the Berne Convention.

In Spain, and many other countries, the default copyright is that authors are the copyright holders and the works have all rights reserved.


- 1. Revising the older journal issues

 - b. The paratexts of the issues (cover, initial or final information), if any
 - c. Paper journal version



How can I correct copyright policy/information?

Modifying the <u>Copyright Notice</u> (in Worfklow/Submission/Author Guidelines) for the text that appear in the Submission public website, that is also the same text that authors must read and accept it before sending a submission.

Modifying the <u>License Terms</u> (in Distribution/License) for the text that appears in each article website.

It is very common error that the Copyright Notice and the License Terms does not align, or they do not show enough information.

The information on the website is easier to change than the metadata.






How can I correct copyright metadata? - manually

If there are few mistakes and/or you do not have an IT team or IT knowledge about OJS, you can correct it manually.

You have to go article by article, in the publication tab of the article submission, unpublish it, click in the Permissions & Disclousure tab, modify the copyright metadata, click save and publish it again in "Schedule for Publication"







How can I correct copyright metadata? - manually

- It could help you if you temporally modify the copyright metadata settings in Distribution/License, so they can match the copyright policy for older articles.
 Do not forget to change it back when you have finished to edit old articles.
- Sometimes it helps to refresh the navigator.
- You might need to erase the copyright holder content in all the language fields, to be able to apply the new metadata settings.





How can I correct copyright metadata? - manually

- If you changed the language options over time, and deleted a language in the language setup, you could have "ghost fields", language fields that exist but you can not see or access. All the fields are in blank but the system detects that they are not completely empty, so the new copyright holder setup can not be applied.
- You can resolve it modifying temporally the language setup
 (Website/Setup/Languages), adding languages in the column "Forms", until you find which one was missing.
- After deleting the information in the ghost field, you can save the new metadata, and put the language setup back of how it was.





How can I correct copyright metadata? – semi-automatic

This is a good option when you have a lot of metadata to correct and if you have an IT team or IT knowledge about OJS.

- 1. Search and extract data from OJS database.
 - Our IT team uses MySQL Workbench https://www.mysql.com/products/workbench/
- 2. Export these data to a format that editors/librarians can manage.

 Our IT team exported to CSV and then they converted into and xlsx file (Excel).
- 3. Editors/Librarians assign new copyright metadata in the file.
- 4. The IT team convert the file to CSV again, and use a PHP script to read and rewrite the new data in the OJS database.



Journals choose their copyright policy

- Different Creative Commons licences
- Different copyright holders (authors/journal)

New and old journals

- Newer journals, born digital
 - Usually, copyright policy since birth
- Older journals, born in paper or other websites
 - Usually, unclear copyright in the first years, and copyright policy implemented later
